Proposed Tree Species Options

Option 1 – Single species (both sides of the road)


<i>Acer platanoides</i> 'Crimson Sentry' (Crimson Sentry Norway Maple)	
Alternating pattern	
	<p>This is a flashy crimson foliated maple with dense upright branching. It has a compact growth habit with its large crimson leaves in summer turning to gold and orange in Autumn. Adds great colour contrast foliage. A small tree with greyish black bark that is lightly textured.</p> <p>Mature Size (height x spread): 5-7m x 5-7m Form: Upright</p>

Option 2 – Single species (both sides of the road)


<i>Tristaniopsis laurina</i> 'Luscious' (Luscious Kanooka)	
	<p>An Australian native. Leaves are dark green, shiny and large. New growth starts in a distinctive copper colour and further interest appears over time with the branches developing deep purple coloured bark which peels back to reveal a smooth, cream trunk. Flowers are yellow and sweetly perfumed, appearing in clusters through summer</p> <p>Mature Size (height x spread): 8m x 4m Form: Oval</p>

Option 3 – Single species (both sides of the road)

<i>Lagerstroemia indica</i> x <i>L. fauriei</i> 'Sioux' (Sioux Upright Crepe Myrtle)	
	<p>Creating quite the visual impact over a lengthy period, this variety offers masses of intense, pink flowers over summer, followed by stunning, rich foliage colour in tones of yellow, red and orange through autumn, before shedding its leaves. When mature, the bark of this variety will peel, creating a mottled effect to reveal the beautiful caramel-pink colour of its under bark.</p> <p>Mature Size (height x spread): 5m x 4m Form: Round</p>

Vacant Site Planting for Carparks Tree Specie

<i>Pyrus calleryana</i> 'Capital' (Ornamental Pear Tree)	
	<p>This tree has a narrow growth habit with luscious shiny green leaves that hang vertically from branches. An attractive curl in the foliage adds further interest and the slender, columnar shape lends itself well to tight spaces. In autumn, leaves turn a purplery-red colour and spring brings a beautiful display of lovely white flowers followed by small, russet coloured fruits.</p> <p>Mature Size (height x spread): 11m x 6m Form: Fastigate</p>
