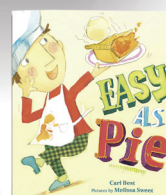
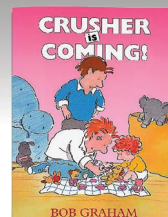
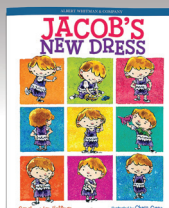
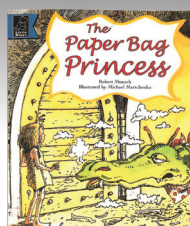
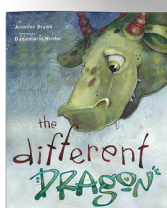
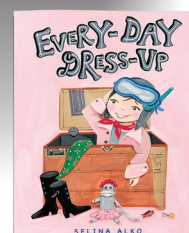
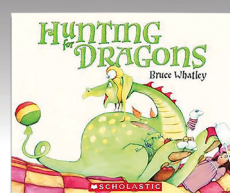
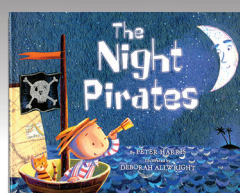
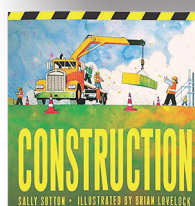
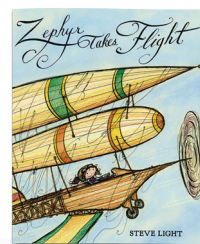
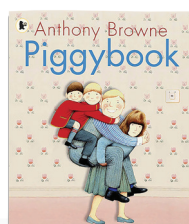
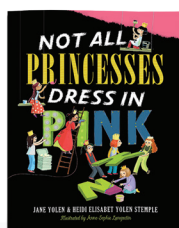


CHILDREN'S PICTURE BOOKS
