**SPECIFICATION NOTES**

**Soil Preparation**  
 Thoroughly aerate and amend soil to a minimum depth of 150mm. All existing soil to be removed from the site of any planting beds and replaced with a suitable topsoil. **Lawn - Hydroseed**  
 Hydroseed areas to be installed where shown. This is to be done by approved methods such as manual removal. Non-residual systemic herbicides should be applied to the lawn area. **Aggregate Gravel Surface**  
 Aggregate gravel surface to be installed where shown. This is to be done by approved methods such as manual removal. Non-residual systemic herbicides should be applied to the lawn area.

**Timber Edges**  
 Timber edges to be installed where shown. This is to be done by approved methods such as manual removal. Non-residual systemic herbicides should be applied to the lawn area.

**Irrigation**

**Repair/Restoration of Damaged Nature-Strips**  
 Repair/Restoration of Damaged Nature-Strips to be installed where shown. This is to be done by approved methods such as manual removal. Non-residual systemic herbicides should be applied to the lawn area.

**Mulch**  
 Mulch to be applied to all garden beds and to be an organic type laid to a minimum depth of 75mm, consisting of fine dark coloured chipmulch or shredded pine bark or hardwood with not more than 5% fines content by volume (preferably zero fines). The average size of the mulch should be approximately 10mm x 20mm x 5mm and the maximum length is to not exceed 30mm. Mulch shall be free of damaging matter such as soil, weeds and sticks and as to be stockpiled and thoroughly washed prior to delivery. Mulch is to be kept back 100mm from the stems of all plants to prevent collar rot.
