Bogong Multi-level Carpark Reopening Update

Dear Owner/ Occupier,

Work to add more than 500 parking spaces to Council's Bogong Avenue car park is expected to be completed by early-April, returning more than 1,000 car parking spaces to the heart of Glen Waverley.

During construction, with the existing car park unavailable, we introduced parking restrictions on surrounding residential streets to accommodate people who live and work in Glen Waverley, and to protect the area from all-day commuter parking.

With significant work and related disruption on the Victorian Government's Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) project expected over the coming years, we will be maintaining these **2P, 8am-8pm, Authorised Vehicles Excepted** and **2P, 8am-8pm** restrictions.

Residents and visitors will be able to park in these restriction areas, with residential parking permits required to be displayed if you plan to stay longer than the allowed time. Whilst we are making some parking available for Council staff and traders to park on the top level of the Bogong car park, they will also be able to continue to park with a valid permit in these residential streets.

How to obtain a Residential Parking Permit

Council's Residential Parking Permit Scheme generally allows single dwelling sites to have up to three (3) permits. The scheme also allows one (1) permit each for 2 – 4 dwelling sites, the older 5 dwelling sites (pre-1995) and 5 – 6 dwellings across a two-house site. The permits are not restricted to an individual car.
