- Incorporate nature based activities
- Adventure play and fitness for all ages
- Bush education
- Social spaces and improved accessibility and amenity

Upper adventure play area with flying fox and social swing, shade sail & sculptural play totems

Play & fitness path climbing up the hill with ropes and balancing logs for play & exercise activities

Tree house with look out and rope climb course up the embankment with lower play elements adjacent to a shaded picnic and seating area

New tree planting to complement existing trees and provide additional shade
BBQ and picnic area under and around existing shelter

Revegetation planting with connecting gravel path creating natural path loops for children near main BBQ and picnic area

Outdoor education area for class groups with interpretive sculptures, seating, signage and specimen plantings

Toddler play area with dry creek bed, swings, slide and balancing play adjacent BBQ and picnic area

Removal of existing informal path to old playground

Main entrance path to provide universal access

Universal access path to existing toilets, carpark and into new play, BBQ and picnic areas
