Monash is home to around 193,000 people, making us one of Victoria's most populous municipalities. We are one of Victoria's most multicultural communities, with 50 per cent of our residents born overseas.

Leafy streetscapes are a feature of our area, as are the 600 hectares of parks, gardens and reserves. We have excellent sporting facilities

catering for football, netball, cricket, swimming, basketball, soccer, softball, golf and more.

Monash is home to some of Melbourne's best-known institutions, including the Monash Medical Centre, Monash University and the Victoria Police Academy.



Lost Cats or Dogs

If you find a lost dog or cat wandering in your neighbourhood, please report it to Council immediately by calling ☎ 9518 3555 (during office hours and after hours). Dogs or cats found wandering in Monash are taken to the RSPCA (in Burwood) where they are cared for until their owners can be located.

Registration, Compulsory Cat Desexing and the Cat Curfew

All cats and dogs aged over three months must be microchipped and registered with Council. Registrations must be renewed each April. Cats that are registered with Monash Council for the first time must be desexed. Exemptions apply, for example if a vet advises against desexing for health reasons.

A night time cat curfew was introduced in Monash in April 2021.





Noise Control

Noise pollution is with us almost all the time but we often do not recognise how serious its effects can be. When dealing with noisy neighbours, the ideal approach is to talk to them and work together to find a solution.

Sometimes noisy neighbours are not aware that they are making unreasonable noise, or that they are annoying or disturbing you. Often talking to them can lead to changes that benefit you both.

If talking to your neighbour does not resolve the problem there are other options. A branch of the Department of Justice called Dispute Settlement Centre of Victoria is available to assist in resolving any civil matter. The service is free and confidential.

Through mediation, both parties aim to reach an amicable agreement. The Dispute Settlement Centre of Victoria can be contacted on ☎ 1300 372 888. Alternatively, visit 🌐 www.disputes.vic.gov.au

Police and Council can also be called upon to see if they can assist with resolving the noise problem. Council may be able to take action under the nuisance provisions of the *Public Health and Wellbeing Act 2008* or for residential noise under the *Environment Protection (Residential Noise) Regulations 2018*. The noise would need to be a nuisance and also dangerous to health or offensive (or liable to be so). Council's Public Health Unit will be able to provide you with advice.

Noise from music/parties that occurs after hours should be referred to police as they can deal with the noise as it is occurring if they deem it to be unreasonable.



To ensure your bin is collected, place it on the nature strip the night before collection. On public holidays, collections will occur as usual.

Food and Garden Waste Collection

In August 2022, Council changed the frequency of food and garden waste (green) bin collection. The 240-litre green bin is collected weekly. This can be used to dispose of garden prunings like grass clippings, flowers, small branches and shrubs, food scraps like fruit, vegetables, meat and seafood, and other organic material like paper towel.

To ensure your green bin is collected, place it on the nature strip the night before collection. Do not place things like general household rubbish and food packaging in your green bin.

This can be used to dispose of glass and plastic jars/bottles; hard plastic food and drink containers including those with the recycling indicator marks; aluminium and steel cans; milk/juice cartons; and newspapers, magazines, office paper, phone books and envelopes.

Please flatten cardboard boxes before placing them in the recycling bin.

Do not place plastic bags, polystyrene, or other rubbish into your recycling bin. To ensure your recycling bin is collected, place it on the nature strip the night before collection.



Emergency Management Plan

Like all municipalities in Victoria, Monash Council has its own Municipal Emergency Management Plan for handling natural disasters and emergencies. This plan, coordinated through Victoria Police by a Municipal Emergency Response Coordinator, sets out the procedures to be followed when Council and community resources are required in the case of an emergency.

Monash is generally a low-risk area, but an appropriate and prompt response may be required in the event of a storm, flood, heatwave, fire, chemical spills, major transport emergency, pandemic, or due to electricity or gas service disruptions. It is important for residents to know how the Municipal Emergency Management Plan operates.

Under the plan, services can be called in to help, including

- Ambulance, fire and police services
- Council
- Other service authorities, the Department of Health and Human Services, other State and Federal government departments, and the media. These organisations have a specific role to play, depending on the nature of the emergency and the need at the time.

How to prepare for emergencies

You can prepare for an emergency by keeping supplies such as:

- Candles
- Torches
- First-aid kits
- Canned food etc.

All members of your family should know where these supplies are kept in your house. Do not depend on power and telephones as they will often fail in an emergency. Radios may be your only means of contact during an emergency – ensure you have a battery-powered radio, and keep spare batteries handy.

Know how and where to turn off your gas, electricity and water. Keep this directory by your telephone, as this information (and the list of important phone numbers on page 3) will always be handy.

What to do in an Emergency

- Stay tuned to a battery-powered radio or TV where possible, to avoid electricity use. A Standard Emergency Warning signal is often used on radio or TV to precede official messages
- Listen carefully as the messages will include instructions on what is happening and what you should do. The warning signal does NOT mean to evacuate
- Police will attempt to notify non-English speaking members of the community with the use of interpreters and ethnic radio stations, however residents should take some responsibility for looking after neighbours who may be elderly, sick or who do not speak English



- Protect pets by ensuring that they can be moved readily if evacuation is necessary
- Use your phone only for emergency. Keep lines clear for essential calls
- If you are not affected, stay home and leave the roads clear for emergency vehicles.

Evacuation Centres

Council has evacuation centres that can be set up in the municipality in case of an emergency. In an event, you may be instructed to evacuate by a police doorknock, or by radio or TV messages. You will be advised at the time where you should go.

Extreme Heat

Heat kills more Australians than any other natural disaster

Remember:

- Drink water
- Hot cars kill
- Keep cool
- Plan ahead
- Help others

People facing emergency medical situations as a result of the heat, or those dealing with fire, should ring 000.

Others needing less urgent medical assistance should contact their doctor or Nurse on Call on 1300 60 60 24 (24 hours).

Groups particularly vulnerable to the effects of hot weather include the elderly, young children, pregnant women, persons with a disability, and people who are frail or sick. Council encourages you to look after yourself and to check in with your elderly, frail or sick friends, relatives and neighbours during hot weather days.
